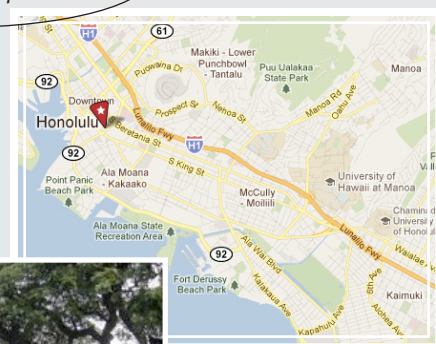

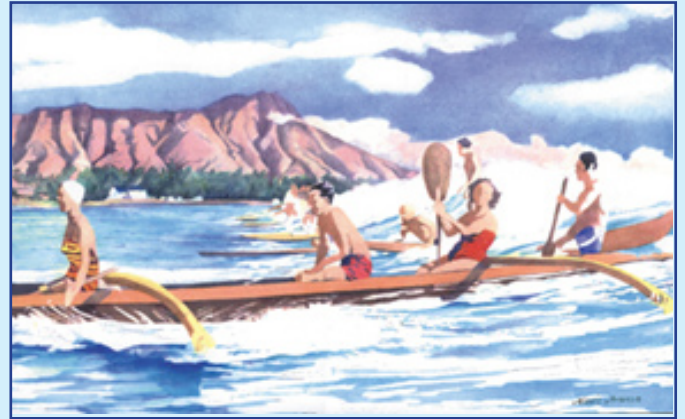

*Here are some suggested resources for learning about outrigger canoe paddling in Hawai'i for the beginner, new resident or visitor. These can be found in the Hawai'i State Library in Honolulu, as well as in some of the other branches of the public library system statewide.*



At the Hawai'i State Library: Start by the Information Desk. Public computers are nearby if you want to search the library's collections and databases. (note: some of the computers and/or databases require a HI library card but some are open to the general public.)

You can search under **Subject Heading (SU) and Keywords** in the HSPLS catalog:

Database commands:

Keywords or Subject:

**CANOES - OUTRIGGER - HAWAII**

When browsing the book shelves: use call number H 797.122 in "Hawaiiiana". You will find most of these references in the Hawai'i-Pacific section of the Hawai'i State Library, which is directly across the courtyard from the library main entrance. The Juvenile and Young Adult fiction for Hawaiiiana is also located in that section. To get there:

*Go past the Info Desk, and through the doors to a lovely central courtyard. Walk across the courtyard ...*
